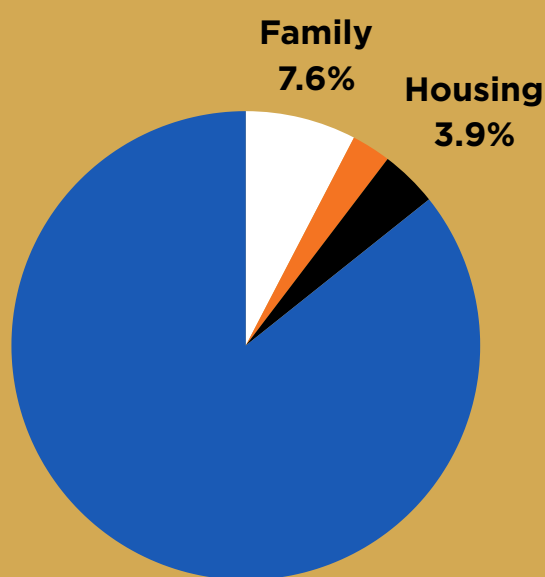

TYPES OF CASES



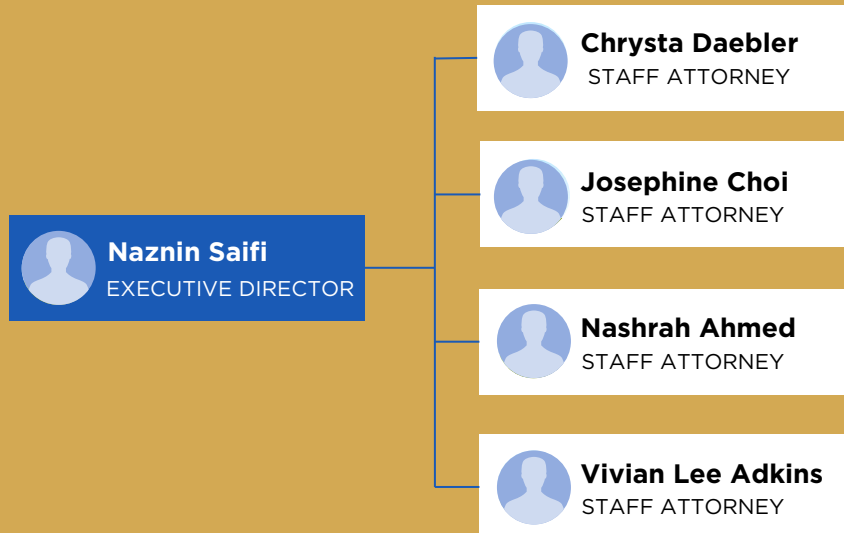
Immigration/Naturalization
